Ruth also longs for a richer, brighter life, but when she finally departs, she finds herself an alien in a modern world of relative abundance. While leaving behind a life of hardship and hard luck, she remains bound – like the long, intertwining roots of prairie grass – to the land and to the memories that tie her to it.*
